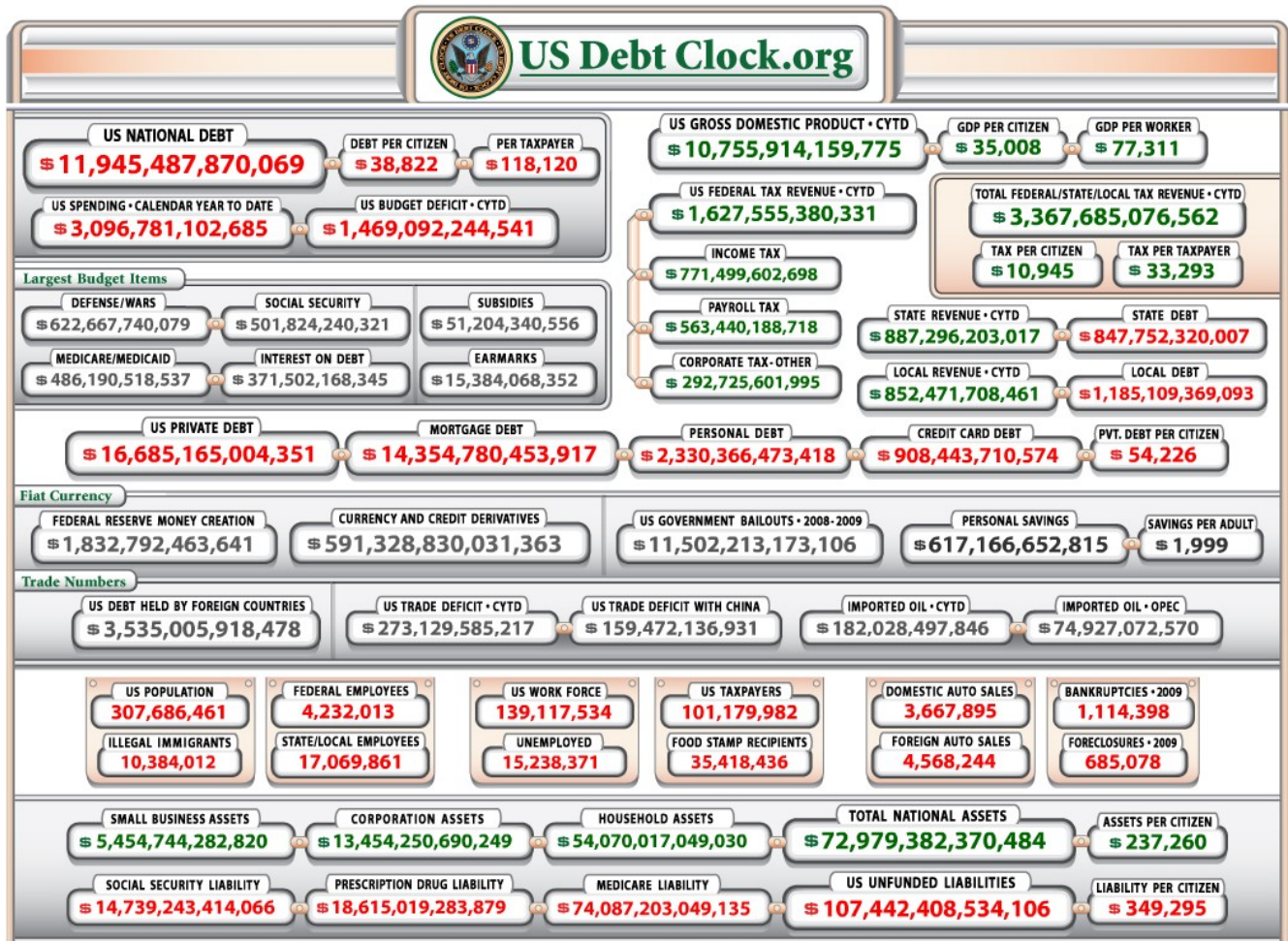


A SNAP SHOT PERSPECTIVE ON THE UNITED STATES DEBT

Visit the web site, USDebtClock.org. The counters are running constantly updating the figures. This is a screen shot taken at about 11:27 am on Columbus Day, October 12, 2009.



This web site is a dynamic display of information so you get a feel for what the financial state of the union looks like. If you put your computer cursor over a figure, the block at the top of the screen shows the source and brief definition. This data, is of course, available to any country that wants to see what is going on in the United States. Note that one trillion has 12 zeros after it, and is the same as a million millions.

The longer you look at it, the more you might ask for answers instead of sound bites. If these figures represented the performance of an insurance company, its officers would be put in jail overnight.
